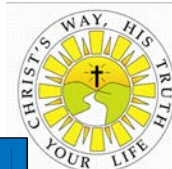

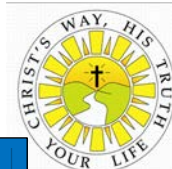

e.g. I invited my friends, Shakespeare, and Byron to dinner.

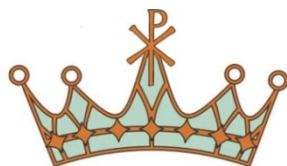
Some argue that that the Oxford comma is old fashioned while others argue that omitting the Oxford comma can lead to confusion.

Re: Extra-Curricular Clubs
